The Camp Fire raged through Butte County in 2018. In its wake, a large population of elderly and retired residents were left without housing or a clear path forward. The scale of destruction was unprecedented.

With your support, HCRN has been on the ground since day one of the Camp Fire, and our staff have worked tirelessly to fill the needs of the community. Thank you so much to our volunteers and donors who were able to secure safe drinking water, food, clothing, and even a shower trailer to meet the needs of a community. While the Camp Fire was almost two and a half years ago, all rebuilding has been slow. Only about 5% of the homes destroyed have been completed or obtained permits to begin rebuilding.



There will always be challenges to rebuilding after disaster, but we rejoice in every victory along the way!
